Another week has flown by. If you were here, you would observe that we have created our quarantine, Covid unit as required by CMS. A huge thank you to those we had to displace. We have rooms, 101, 102,103, 104, first on your left on Bridge Wing, designated for new admission quarantining for 14 days, as needed, and residents we test for Covid.
