Hello Families, Residents and Friends: It is only Tuesday, but lots to share. Please read carefully!

First, We have all our results back from our 6/9 testing, (Finally) and everyone was negative! All of ST Teresa staff and residents, Bishop Primeau was included and all negative as well. Our Sentinel Testing will commence on Thursday and will be every Thursday at least for 4 weeks. This testing will be for all our staff each week and 10% of our residents. We have an algorithm to follow to select our 10% - Reminding all to be mindful in the use of masks when out in public, safe social distancing and good hand washing always.

Other EXCITING News. We will be starting outside visits next Monday. We only have this option as a Covid Free Center. There are many constraints in the guidance we must adhere to. First the visits must be scheduled and you must be screened in advance, as well as the day of the visit. ONLY 2 visitors will be permitted. No one under the age of 12. No pets are allowed, no food please. YOU must wear a mask, and remain 6 feet apart at all times. We plan to use the Gazebo out front. You will be screened at the front door and your family member brought out. We must have a staff member present for the visit, so our schedule for visits must keep this in mind. We are scheduling 30 minute visits, with 15 breaks to sanitize between visits, so that everyone has the opportunity to have a family member visit. So once you have a visit scheduled, please understand we need to give everyone a chance before we schedule another visit. You must call the center, speak to Rachel or Luanne or Ellen to be screened and schedule a visit. We would like to begin scheduling for next week. These are the time slots we have established. Tuesday and Thursday have 2 evening visit slots. Call with questions, we will be asking you questions to schedule the visit.
