Happy Friday Everyone: Happy Father's Day to all the Dads our there!

We completed our first round of Surveillance COVID-19 testing yesterday. We tested all our staff again and 6 residents. We will be able to access the results on line by Monday. This will continue for the next 4 weeks.

We will be starting outside visits on Monday. The schedule filled up fast, but on Monday you can call and see if there are openings that would work for you. We only have this option as a COVID Free Center and the only way we can stay COVID Free is if we do these visits carefully and by the rules. There are many constraints in the guidance we must adhere to. First the visits <u>must be</u> scheduled and you must be screened in advance, as well as the day of the visit. ONLY 2 visitors will be permitted. No one under the age of 12. No pets are allowed, no food or drink please. YOU must wear a mask, and remain 6 feet apart at all times. NO Hugs allowed, no touching. We plan to use the Gazebo out front for most of our visits and we have a plan B alternative as well outside. Please ring the doorbell and You will be screened at the front door and your family member brought out. We must have a staff member present for the visit, so our schedule for visits must keep this in mind. We are scheduling 30 minute visits, with 15 breaks to sanitize between visits, so that everyone has the opportunity to have a family member visit. So once you have a visit scheduled, please understand we need to give everyone a chance before we schedule another visit. You must call the center, speak to Rachel or Luanne to be screened and schedule a visit. We would like to begin scheduling for next week. These are the time slots we have established. Tuesday and Thursday have 2 evening visit slots. Call with questions, we will be asking you questions to schedule the visit.
