Hello families, residents and friends! Happy Friday from the St. Teresa staff. We certainly are busy. And the Fourth of July is fast approaching.

We continue to do our Surveillance testing (10% of our residents and all staff). We had all negative results last week (6/18) with 1 test with insufficient sample. We retested again yesterday (6/25). Thursday is our Testing day. We have 2 more cycles in this initial plan by the State of NH. Rest assured you will hear from me if we have any positive Covid results.

Please remember to be safe. Wear a mask, social distance, avoid crowds and wash your hands. You can help keep us all safe and well.

We started outside visits on Monday. The schedule has filled up fast, but you can call (Monday – Friday) and see if there are openings that would work for you. We only have this option as a Covid Free Center and the only way we can stay Covid Free is if we do these visits carefully and by the rules. There are many constraints in the guidance we must adhere to.

- You must call the center, **Speak to Rachel or Luanne** to be screened and schedule a visit. Only they can confirm your visit. You must call in advance.
- **Visits must be scheduled and you must be screened in advance**, as well as on the day of the visit.
- **ONLY 2 visitors** will be permitted. No one under the age of 12. No pets are allowed, no food or drink please.
- **YOU must wear a mask, and remain 6 feet apart at all times.** NO Hugs allowed, no touching.
- **We plan to use the Gazebo out front for most of our visits and we have a plan B alternative outside.**
- Please ring the doorbell and You will be screened at the front door and your family member brought out. We must have a staff member present for the visit, so our schedule for visits must keep this in mind.
- We are scheduling 30 minute visits, with 15 breaks to sanitize between visits, so that everyone has the opportunity to have a family member visit. So once you have a visit scheduled, please understand we need to give everyone a chance before we schedule another visit. These are the time slots we have established. Tuesday and Thursday have evening visit slots.
