Hello families, residents and friends,

Hope you have safe plans for the Fourth of July weekend. Wear a mask, socially distance, no large gatherings, and wash your hands frequently - Please.

I write on Tuesday, since I am lucky enough to have some time off over this coming holiday weekend. I will call it a staycation. I will be here for our testing on Thursdays, but off July 1-10.

We have our results from last Thursday (6/25). We were negative for our residents tested and for our staff as well, except for 2 specimens that were inadequate. DPH told us to just test again on Thursday. So that is our plan. Testing again on Thursday, July 2nd and July 9th. If there is any news, You will hear from Rachel / Dawn, or possibly even me.

Outside Visits continue, weather permitting.... We have this week now fully booked and continuing to fill next week. Please call and speak to Rachel to set something up!

Remember the only way we can stay COVID Free, and offer these visits, is if we do these visits carefully and by the rules. There are many constraints in the guidance we must adhere to.

- You must call the center, **Speak to Rachel** to be screened and schedule a visit. You must call in advance.
- **Visits must be scheduled** and **you must be screened in advance**, as well as on the day of the visit.
- **ONLY 2 visitors** will be permitted. No one under the age of 12. No pets are allowed, no food or drink please.
- **YOU must wear a mask, and remain 6 feet apart at all times.** NO Hugs allowed, no touching.
- **We plan to use the Gazebo out front for most of our visits and we have a plan B alternative outside.**
- Please ring the doorbell and you will be screened at the front door and your family member brought out. We must have a staff member present for the visit, so our schedule for visits must keep this in mind.
- We are scheduling 30 minute visits, with 15 breaks to sanitize between visits, so that everyone has the opportunity to have a family member visit. So once you have a visit scheduled, please understand we need to give everyone a chance before we schedule another visit. These are the time slots we have established. Tuesday and Thursday have evening visit slots.
