Hello, families, residents, staff and friends,

As I shared earlier, we are monitoring all residents each shift for signs or symptoms related to Covid19. These symptoms include fever, cough, chills, muscle aches, headache, sore throat, runny nose, congestion, shortness of breath, new loss of taste or smell and or diarrhea. Based on our monitoring, we did test 3 new residents with our Point of Care quick testing machine. Those 3 came back positive. Nursing contacted those who tested positive. Our total Positive cases for Staff members is currently 5 and Residents has totaled 20.

We are testing everyone again tomorrow with the State of NH Mobile unit, using the most accurate test. All Staff and residents. I will keep you posted through these challenging times.

I will remind you that these emails and updates are related to Covid19 and I must remain HIPPA compliant and not share any specifics.

Please stay safe! Wear a mask, stay socially distant when out and don't plan on any large group gatherings.

The City of Manchester and State of NH numbers keep growing. Community spread is real and incubation time is 14 days.

Our nemesis is asymptomatic spread.
