Families, residents, staff and friends,

Sadly, I must share that we lost 3 resident family members last evening. All had previously tested positive for Covid19. Our hearts are breaking... and we grieve with their families. I want to assure you that no one leaves us alone.

This was our prayer we prayed together today:

Dear Jesus, Divine Physician and Healer of the sick, we turn to You in this time of illness. O dearest Comforter of the troubled, alleviate our worry and sorrow with Your gentle love, and grant us the grace and strength to accept this burden. Dear God we place our worries in Your hands. We place our sick under Your care and humbly ask You to restore your servant to health again. Above all, grant us the grace to acknowledge Your Holy will and know whatsoever You do, You do for the love of us. AMEN.

We have had a total of 20 residents test positive since our outbreak began. Thank you for your prayers as we provide support and care to those who are ill. Nursing will be keeping you updated with changes in symptoms and your loved ones condition. Ellen, our social worker, is also helping with updates and communication on advance directives.

We currently have 5 positive staff members out, with a variety of symptoms. A few are soon returning as they have healed. WE screen our staff daily as well. 3 more staff members have symptoms, are out of work, and await their test results.

We tested all previously negative residents, and staff again yesterday and anticipate finding a few more positive results with staff and residents. We will continue testing every Thursday until we go 2 weeks with no new positive cases.

We have tested the Bishop Primeau tenants as well, but I do not report those test and results to you, only those done on our St. Teresa residents and staff. I will tell you that none have been found positive. We have been carefully keeping them separate from St. Teresa.
