It has been a busy and positive week.

TESTING: We tested on Tuesday and all results were negative for COVID-19, all staff and residents. We need another good week of testing again on Tuesday!

VACCINE: We will be holding our second Walgreens vaccination clinic on Monday 1/18. For all those who received their 1st dose on 12/28, this 2nd dose will complete their vaccination for COVID-19. This includes all but 2 residents and it looks like we have almost 70% of staff signed up as well. We will have a 3rd clinic on 2/8 for all that get their first dose on Monday 1/18. We can not start anyone new in this program at this 3rd clinic. We are waiting to learn how we can vaccinate any new residents going forward. There are many moving pieces in the puzzle of vaccinating all of NH.
