Hello Resident, families and friends,

I have been waiting on this weeks test results to update you. We were ever hopeful we have a second week with no positive results in residents, tenants or staff. So.....

TESTING: We tested 132 Residents, tenants, and staff this week. We have all of them back and all have been negative! Since this is our second week with no new positive findings, we are cleared from outbreak status by public health. We will continue follow their guidance. The positive rate of infection in Manchester list week was very close to 5% at 4.6%. We receive updated stats on positivity in the community early each week. It has been steadily rising. That Delta variant is very transmissible. When / if we hit 5%, we will move to weekly PCR testing of unvaccinated. We had been PCR testing monthly and POC Binax now testing weekly, prior to our positive results.

Visits: We would like to ease back into visits. Rachel is on vacation next week as well, so appointments will need to go through me.....We need to continue to prescreen you and limit your visits to common areas that allow us to clean between visits. Given the high transmission rate, we ask you to wear a mask, vaccinated or not, for safety. WE really encourage all visitors to be vaccinated. If you would like information on the vaccine or would like to get it at our next clinic on Friday, 8/13, Let us know ASAP. We offer all 3, Pfizer, Moderna and J&J, just need to know in advance.
